

The Audrey Fagan Young Women's Enrichment Grants highlight the ACT Government's commitment to the development of opportunities for young women. This supports the government's efforts in creating a community where women are safe, healthy, equally represented, and valued for their contribution to society. Enrichment Grants provide young women aged 12 to 18 years with an opportunity to receive support to develop a project that will assist them to achieve their goals. Enrichment Grants aim to inspire young women to enhance their skills and knowledge within their area of interest. It provides an opportunity for young women to make decisions, take responsibility, or initiate projects in collaboration with an experienced mentor of their choice.

The **Enrichment Grants** provide young women with an opportunity to realise their dreams in a collaborative relationship with a mentor.

Young women aged between 12 and 18, residents of the ACT or undertaking education in the ACT are eligible to apply. The program provides one off grants of up to **\$2,000** to support young women to **achieve a project in their area of interest.**

The **Enrichment Grants** are a component of the **Audrey Fagan Program** established in 2007 to honour former ACT Chief Police Officer Audrey Fagan's contribution as an inspirational leader and mentor for young women.
